This award commemorates the outstanding achievements of Trisha Flett and Sally-Jane Allen in the sports of athletics, netball and basketball at club, association, state and national levels.

In January 1990 they tragically lost their lives while travelling home from Albury after representing South Australia Country in the Australian Junior Country Basketball Cup.

The sporting community of Mount Gambier that year supported a fundraising campaign to establish this sporting scholarship to commemorate the girls' achievements.

1. Purpose

To provide funding for eligible junior sports persons to further develop their chosen sport.

2. Management

The Selection Committee shall consist of four members from within the area covered by the boundaries of the Mount Gambier city and District Council of Grant areas, to be appointed annually by the Trustees.

3. Eligibility

To qualify for this award a Junior Sportsplayer shall be under the age of sixteen (16) years on the 1st day of January prior to the date of selection, and participate in the area covered by the boundaries of the Mount Gambier City and District Coucil of Grant areas.

4. Conditions of Scholarship

The awarding of the Scholarship is subject to the recipient and parent or guardian, agreeing to be bound by the following conditions signed between the selection committee and the recipient and parent or guardian.

- a. Timing: The Scholarship shall be taken in the twelve months following selection.
- b. Funding: The trustees will provide a cheque to the recipient to be spent in support of their sporting aspirations. The maximum value of the Scholarship will be determined each year by the Trustees.
- c. Sportscene will donate a sports bag and a sports voucher to the scholarship winner.
- d. Squashbrook Fitness & Leisure will donate a lifestyle membership to the scholarship winner.
- e. Indemnity: An appropriate indemnity absolving the selection committee from liability must be signed by the parent/guardian as a condition of acceptance of the Scholarship.

5. Selection

- a. Associations & Schools will be called to nominate juniors by the published due date.
- b. The selection of recipients is at the absolute discretion of the Selection Committee.

6. Advice to Candidates

Successful candidates will be announced at the presentation of all applicants at a function to be organised by the trustees.

7. Termination/ Suspension

This Scholarship may be terminated or suspended before the approved completion date, either at the recipient's/s request or if in the opinion of the Selection Committee the performance is unsatisfactory, or a recipient is guilty of misconduct or failure, within reason.
