## 2018 WELCOME AND INFORMATION EVENING LOCATIONS

- 1. SAUSAGE SIZZLE will be available throughout the evening at the Sugarloaf Café. INFORMATION BOOTHS Find out more about BYOD, PAM, Studiosity (previously YourTutor) and Skoolbag.
- 2. POPLARS Families will have the opportunity to meet teachers with classrooms open from 4:30pm to 5:30pm.
- 3. RECEPTION TO YEAR 5 Families will have the opportunity to meet classroom teachers with classrooms open from 5:00pm to 6:00pm. The 'open classroom' is designed for your child to share their work with you and for you to tour the classroom environment and other areas your child will be in throughout the year.
- 4. YEAR 5 STUDENTS: As well as the open classrooms, Year 5 families are encouraged to attend an Information Session from 6:00pm to 6:30pm which will outline the Year 5 Instrumental Program. This will be held in the Lecture Theatre of the Pam Ronan Centre (downstairs). Year 5 students will be informed of their instrument allocation and instrumental teachers will demonstrate, to parents and students, correct care and use of their instrument.
- 5. YEARS 6 & 7: From 6:00pm, Year 6 and 7 classrooms will be open in the Thomas Ryan Building, where individual information sessions will be held in each home room. This will give you the opportunity to meet your child's homegroup teacher, as well as walk through the Thomas Ryan Building and see the environment your child will be studying in during the year.
