

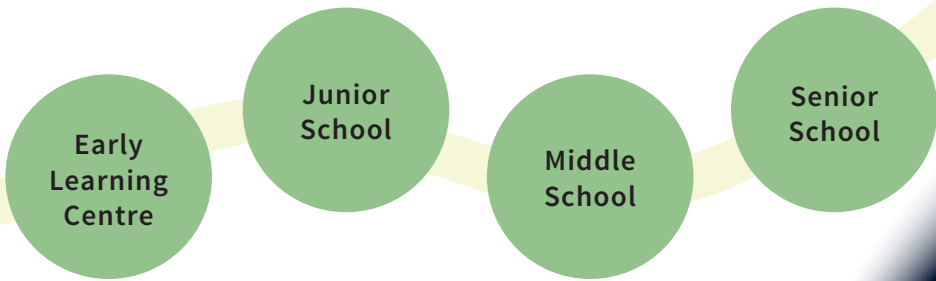


STEWARDSHIP OF CREATION
