'Leading from Within' - Our Leaders Shine

During the student vacation 12 staff leaders of Tenison Woods College, participated in the leadership program "Leading from Within" that was facilitated by the internationally recognised *Brown Collective*. Stephen Brown founder and facilitator of the program indicated that the collective is anchored by agreed ideals and ways of working: an explicit commitment to excellence informed by research and evidence; shared values; ethical and sustainable practices; and a clear moral purpose.

Stephen and co-facilitator Phil Holmes, acknowledged the importance of identifying, supporting and developing a diverse range of leaders, and through the program providing an opportunity for individuals to self-reflect about their leadership capabilities, understand the importance of interpersonal relationships in their leadership, and make a contribution to the shared direction of their school and the broader system.

We were very fortunate that 12 of our staff, with three staff from Mary MacKillop Memorial School and St Anthony's Catholic School participated in two days of high energy facilitation by two highly regarded facilitators, and I look forward to the outcomes of the leadership challenge projects which each participant will complete this year.

Wellbeing and Engagement Collection Survey - Week 2

Students in our school will be invited to take part in a survey being conducted next week.

Young people's sense of wellbeing is an important part of how they learn at school. The purpose of the survey is to seek students' views about their wellbeing and their engagement with school. The information collected will help the education system and broader community to support young people's health and wellbeing.

The survey asks students about their social and emotional wellbeing; school relationships and engagement and learning in school; and physical health and wellbeing and after school activities. Students' answers will be kept confidential – no one (including school staff) will use the results to identify individual students.




Leading from Within Workshops


